Greater Brandvlei Dam is near Worcester located on a tributary of the Breede River. It was formed by joining the original Brandvlei Dam (Lake Marais) which was constructed in 1983 and the Kwaggaskloof Dam in 1989. It is a popular venue for water skiers and it also hosts the Worcester Yacht Club.
